- Prior to set up his own business, the Chief Executive Officer of this organisation was a long time employee of TAFE colleges in various States of Australia.
- The organisational structure of the organisation consists of a Managing Director, Business Manager, and 7 contract trainers/assessors.
- The organisation delivers non-accredited training for corporate clients in the area of performance management.
- Many of the clients requesting accredited training and assessment are also corporate clients, as

opposed to general public. The corporate clients include several councils based in Western Australia.

- The mix of clients undertaking training include existing workers, middle management, parks and gardens employees, and, for aged care, new entrants.
- Training is delivered fee for service and under User Choice contracts with the Queensland and Western Australian Governments.
- This organisation delivers training and assessment primarily in Western Australia, Victoria and Queensland.
- No partnering arrangements are undertaken by this organisation.

Reasons for finding of non-compliance:

The organisation provided a training and assessment strategy for AHC40410 Certificate IV in Horticulture which did not meet the packaging rules of the training package. The organisation had substituted BSBHRM405A Support the recruitment, selection and induction of staff for BSBHRM402A Recruit, select and inducts staff.

Prior to the conclusion of the audit, the organisation provided evidence that rectified the identified non-compliance. Consequently, no further evidence is required.

15.3 Staff, facilities, equipment and training and assessment materials used by the NVR registered training organisation are consistent with the requirements of the Training Package or VET accredited course and the NVR registered training organisation's own training and assessment strategies and are developed through effective consultation with industry.
